The wetting additive reduces the viscosity of the plastisol at low shear forces. BYK-1166 is particularly recommended for chemically foamed PVC plastisols regarding white index and surface properties. Its effectiveness is primarily dependent on the PVC resin used.

Recommended Levels

0.5-3 % additive (as supplied) based on the PVC resin.

The above recommended levels can be used for orientation. Optimal levels are determined through a series of laboratory tests.

Incorporation and Processing Instructions

The additive may be added during the plastisol manufacturing process or shortly prior to processing.
